What will we be learning?

English

Reading and writing is taught through a scheme called 'Read, Write Inc'.

During this time the children will learn the pure sounds that letters make and will learn how to write them using the correct formation.



Maths

This term we will be concentrating on counting skills and matching quantities to the correct numeral.

We will be exploring numbers using Numicon and writing numbers in the correct formation.


Independent Learning
